

A tailored, multichannel communications campaign invited HCPs to participate.



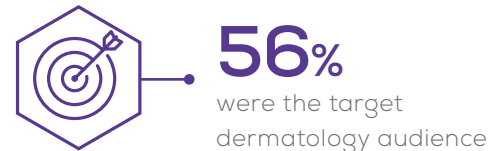
